Questions for Discussion and Reflection Sunday, July 5, 2020 Ecclesiastes 5:1-7

We've provided these questions to give families or groups (of all ages) and individuals an opportunity to reflect on today's message. We hope you'll use them over lunch or dinner today to consider more fully the teaching of Ecclesiastes 5:1-7.

- 1. Today's passage is dealing with the nature of worship How would you define worship in your own words?
- 2. When we talked about guarding our steps as we come to worship, we talked about Moses and the burning bush. Why do you think God asked Moses to take off his shoes as he walked to the burning bush?
- 3. King Saul said he listened to God, but he deliberately didn't do what God had asked him to do. Do you ever say you're listening, but later you forget what they said or what they asked you to do? How could you be a better listener in those times?
- 4. Why do you think the Israelites made a golden calf as an idol after God had just freed them from Egypt?
- 5. Read Hebrews 10:19-22 How do you think this passage should impact how we approach worship?
