1. How do the priorities of Paul's prayer compare with your prayers?
2. If or where your prayers are different, what might this suggest about your view of God, or what matters to you in life?
3. How does this passage cause you to want to pray?
4. Paul puts *knowledge* and *love* together in this prayer. Why is it critical to keep these two virtues together?
5. How does *knowledge of God* inform and inspire *love for God* and *love for others*?
